**Angela Merkel: “We need more Europe”**

**Okay, but... what kind of Europe does she envisage? What would its future look like?**

Dear Mr. Johnson,

to this very day the German Chancellor refuses to answer this burning question although the people in the European Union and its member states are eagerly waiting for clarification.

But how can we even expect Europe to have a future at all if it aborts its own children? In the European Union 3,345 unborn children are killed each day (figures for 2015/2016). That comes down to 100,350 per month and 1,204,200 per year.

The killing of unborn children was first decreed in dictatorial manner in the Communist countries of the former Eastern Bloc, but since 1967 it has also been propagated step by step in Western countries. The best known of the early abortion lobbyists in the West were Margaret Sanger and Marie Stopes, both of them committed racists and fervent admirers of Hitler. The chronology sheds a light on the historical background. No woman, let alone a democratic election, has ever granted you the political mandate to pursue this crime against humanity which, by the way, is in conflict with the EU Charter.

Nonetheless the EU takes center stage as a proactive abortion lobbyist and demands the enforcement of infanticide, even in places where EU citizens have until now successfully resisted or have started to opt out of the abortion business (see enclosed list).

As EU citizens we definitely want to have a future – therefore the mass murder of innocent children has to stop. Europe needs genuinely children- and family-friendly policies which deserve to be described as such. What can reasonably be achieved these days is demonstrated by countries such as Hungary and Poland.

Please see to it that the European Parliament changes its current course, puts an end to the direct or indirect promotion of abortion and disentangles itself from the abortion industry.
